We are committed to the growth of artistic swimming athletes and coaches both in and out of the pool.

Summary of Position:

Reporting to the Head Coach, we are looking for an individual with experience in artistic swimming to coach our competitive athletes for 20+ hours on deck a week with an additional 5 hours a week for administrative and planning. Additional hours are available for coaching solos, duets and extra figure practice, summer camps, competitions and Aquatica events.

This position will have the opportunity to travel nationally for artistic swimming competitions. Travel, accommodations and meal allowance provided as well as a per diem honorarium. We encourage all our coaches to continue their professional development and offer assistance to help cover costs.

Responsibilities:

- Lead coach for a competitive artistic swimming team including seasonal and practice planning, choreography of routines, programming for figures and workouts, coaching at competitions and communication with parents and implementing practice plans.
- Create and train solos and duets with other coaches
- Work to develop lifelong athletes that have good sportsmanship, confidence, and character beyond the sport of artistic swimming
- Assisting other artistic swimming coaches and teams within our club
- Assisting head coach with technical support off deck to support the development of other Aquatica Coaches
- Attend Coaches meetings, club functions (watershows, training camps etc.), and professional development opportunities
- Complete athlete evaluations twice a year
