This dynamic individual must possess strong interpersonal and leadership skills and support both team and club unity through effective communication.

Summary of Position:

The Senior Coach works with the Head Coach to promote and develop athletes and coaches, as well as ensure leadership and execution of club programs and competitions. Reporting to the Head Coach, the Senior Coach provides leadership for recreational and Steinbach programming. They must be well versed in the Canadian Sport for Life Long Term Athlete Development model and willing to support all Club athletes to achieve their personal best through a holistic approach.

Responsibilities:

- Act as the Recreation program liaison ensuring parents and swimmers receive information required for effective program communication and understanding in a timely manner
- Act as Steinbach liaison, ensuring that the day to day pool activities are running smoothly including that coaches are fulfilling their duties. This includes being available during practice times and able to attend 2/3 practices a week.
- Maintain the club's equipment inventory and assist head coach with coordination of new purchases as required
- Work as a mentor for new and younger coaches
- Coordinate the try it days for new recreational athletes in September and January, including providing a plan for coaches, ensuring there are athletes available to demonstrate skills, and distributing program information to interested parents.

- Assist with special events planning as required
